

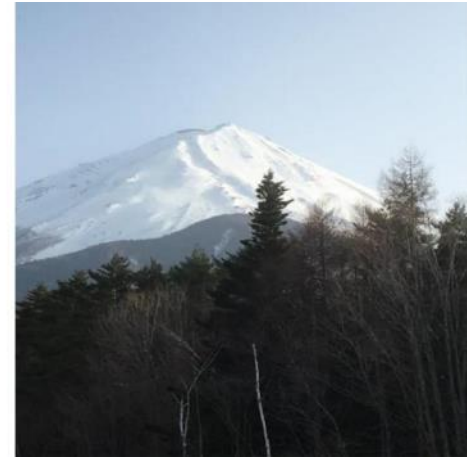

# Traditions – Buddhas, Buddhist & Shinto temples, Pagodas & Tori gates

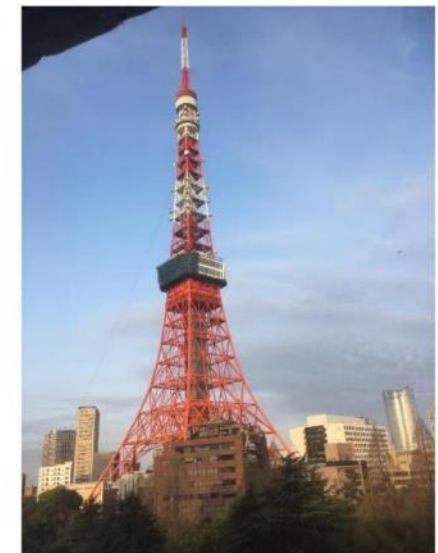

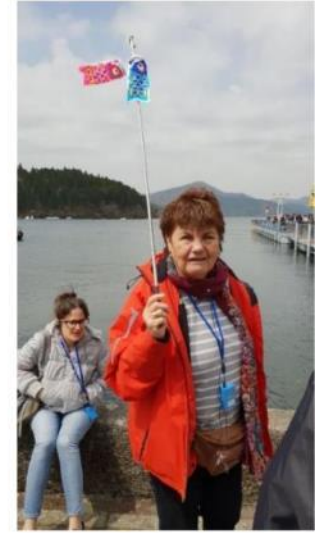
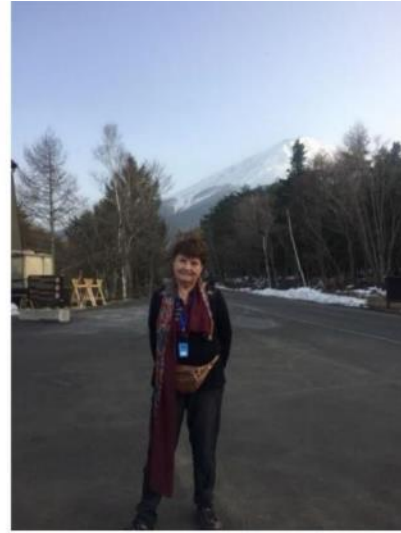
