

Dr Tiberiu Ezri



Dr Tiberiu Ezri was born in Romania in 1951 and went on to become board certified in anaesthesia in Israel in 1983.

Dr Ezri has been Head of the Department of Anaesthesia at the Wolfson Medical Centre, affiliated to Tel Aviv University since 2000. He has been leading the Wolfson MC team in performing anaesthesia for cardiac surgeries on thousands of children from over 40 low resource countries, including educating (in paediatric cardiac anaesthesia) young anaesthesiologists from those countries.

He was also WFSA Program Director at Wolfson MC from 2006-2014, educating 36 fellows from nine countries (Kenya, Nigeria, Uzbekistan, Romania, Republic of Moldova, Bulgaria, Serbia, Slovakia, Czech Republic) in the fields of cardiac, obstetric and paediatric anaesthesia, pain medicine and intensive care. Some of these doctors (Dr. Sotonye, Dr. Nwasor) have become leaders in their fields in their home countries.

WFSA Distinguished Service Award
